General Excellence Scholarships 2020 (Years 10-13)

Rangi Ruru Girls' School is pleased to offer General Excellence Scholarships for girls at Years 10-13. Scholarships are awarded to girls who show strength and potential in two or more of the following areas: academic, cultural, sporting, music, citizenship or leadership.

The Scholarships offered for 2020 are subject to annual review of continued progress and application, school involvement and attitude. Scholarships are for a portion of the tuition fees ranging from 25% to 50% of fees. General Excellence Scholarships are available for up to four years tuition subject to continued academic progress, application, school involvement and adherence to school values.

If a girl has a special strength in Music, please note this and be prepared to attend an audition if required. Girls who are selected to be auditioned for a will be given an audition time of approximately 20 minutes. This audition will consist of a short performance of two contrasting pieces, aural tests, sight reading and a brief discussion on the music performed. Candidates must provide their own accompanist at their cost or may use a backing track if appropriate.

Applicants must be New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents to be eligible to apply for a General Excellence Scholarship.

Tenure of the Scholarship will be reviewed annually and is subject to good conduct, adherence to the Rangi values and academic progress in keeping with the status of the award.

Our Fees

- Current tuition fees for 2019 are (inclusive of GST) - Year 10 – 13 Day Student - \$21,735 per annum (for New Zealand students)
- Boarding fees 2019 (where applicable) - \$14,000 per annum
- Incidentals including uniform, stationery, outdoor education camp etc approximately \$2,500 per annum

Costs

A **\$100 registration fee** is required for girls to sit scholarship. Those who have already submitted a General Application for enrolment, **do not** have to pay an additional fee. Girls whose mother is an Old Girl of Rangi Ruru Girls' School are exempt from this fee. For those students who are successful in gaining a scholarship to Rangi Ruru, this will be credited to their account when they commence with us.

Scholarship Offers and Results

The school reserves the right to seek further information from an applicant's present school before a final decision is made.

Once those offered Scholarships have confirmed their acceptance, all Scholarship entrants will be contacted by email to advise the outcome of their application. **This process can take two to three weeks.**
