Scholarships for Students Entering Year 7 in 2020

Rangi Ruru Girls' School is pleased to offer Scholarships for girls entering Year 7 in 2020. Scholarships are awarded for academic excellence, for excellence in music, and all-round ability.

Applicants must be New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents and currently in Year 6 to be eligible to sit for the Year 7, 2020 Scholarship examination.

Scholarships are for a portion of tuition fees ranging from 25% to 50%, depending on the calibre and circumstances of the student. All Scholarships are available for two years tuition, subject to continued academic progress, application, school involvement and adherence to school values. In the case of the Stellar Music Scholarship, continued full involvement in school music is a requirement.

Those students who sit Scholarship in Year 7 are eligible to sit for the Year 9 Rangi Ruru Entrance Scholarship examinations when they are in Year 8.

Rangi Ruru Old Girls' Association Scholarship

The Rangi Ruru Old Girls' Association offers a scholarship that provides \$4000 per year credited against tuition fees for two years for a very academically able student entering Rangi Ruru at Year 7. Very academically able usually means girls who score in the 85th plus percentile in all PATs, are working above the expected level, or who have gained Distinction or High Distinction in the ICAS. The student awarded the scholarship will be the daughter of a Rangi Ruru Old Girl.

Academic Scholarships

The number and value of these scholarships is determined on an annual basis. They are awarded for academic excellence, however, high performance in other areas is taken into consideration. These scholarships are offered for between 25-50% of tuition fees for **two years**.

General Excellence Scholarships

The number and value of these scholarships is determined on an annual basis. These are awarded to girls who show strength and potential in two or more of the following areas: academic, cultural, sporting and leadership. These scholarships are offered for between 25-50% of tuition fees **for two years**. If a girl has a special strength in Music, please note this and be prepared to attend an audition if required.

Stellar Music Scholarships

Girls who are selected to be auditioned for a Stellar Music Scholarship will be given an audition time of approximately 20 minutes. This audition will consist of a short performance of two contrasting pieces, aural tests, sight reading and a brief discussion on the music performed. Candidates must provide their own accompanist at their cost or may use a backing track if appropriate. Further details will be given on notification of selection for audition.

Students who gain Scholarships benefit from Rangī Ruru's high standards of excellence and their contribution to school life is valued.

General Information

The examinations will be held at Rangī Ruru Girls' School on **Wednesday 15 May** with girls required to be at the school by 1.00pm. The examinations consist of tests in English, Mathematics, Reasoning and Creativity of a standard that can be reasonably attempted by very academically able students in Year 6. (Each test lasts approximately 40 minutes).

All students are required to sit the Academic examination regardless of the Scholarship they are applying for.

Full details of the examination day will be sent following receipt of your Registration form and once registrations have closed on **Wednesday 8 May at 4.00pm**.

Note: If your daughter is on our pre-enrolment list for entry it is still necessary to complete and return the Scholarship Registration form.

Sample papers from previous examinations are not available.

Those selected for **Stellar Music Scholarship or other auditions** will be contacted regarding their audition time. These auditions will be held on **Thursday 30 May** at Rangī Ruru Girls' School.

Costs

A **\$100 registration fee** is required for girls to sit scholarship. Those who have already submitted a General Application for enrolment, **do not** have to pay an additional fee. Girls whose mother was an Old Girl of Rangī Ruru Girls' School are exempt from this fee. For those students who are successful in gaining a scholarship to Rangī Ruru, this will be credited to their account when they commence with us.

Our Fees

- Current tuition fees for Years 7 2019 are (inclusive of GST) – Day Student - \$18,980 per annum (for New Zealand students)
- Boarding fees 2019 (where applicable) - \$14,000 per annum
- Incidentals including uniform, stationery, outdoor education camp etc approximately \$2,500 per annum

Scholarship Offers and Results

Following the Scholarship examinations, an email confirming the process from here onwards will be sent to all students who sat the Scholarship exam. **The final process can take two to three weeks.**

Actual marks attained in the examinations are not given to candidates but may be disclosed at the discretion of the Principal. Acceptance of this proviso is a condition of the candidate's entry and registration for the examinations. Examination answer papers are not available.

Tenure of the Scholarship will be reviewed annually and is subject to good conduct, adherence to the Rangī values and academic progress in keeping with the status of the award.
