## General Excellence Scholarships 2021 (Years 10-13)

Rangi Ruru Girls' School offers scholarships opportunities to highly motivated girls entering with abilities across many areas of life.

These areas include Academic, Music, Sport, Leadership and Cultural contributions and talents. In order to be considered for these prestigious scholarships, girls must be willing to contribute and participate fully in the life of Rangi Ruru, upholding our values and embracing our spirit. These sought-after opportunities are for girls entering Year 10 - 13 in 2021.

Applicants must be New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents and currently in Years 9 to 12 to be eligible to apply for Scholarship.

Our scholarship recipients are not only given financial support to attend Rangi Ruru, they are immersed in programmes that ensure they reach their full potential.

Scholarships are for a portion of tuition fees, depending on the calibre and circumstances of the student. All Scholarships are available and subject to continued academic progress, application, school involvement and adherence to school values. In the case of a Scholarship being awarded with a music component, continued full involvement in school curricular and co-curricular music is a requirement over the scholarship tenure.

### General Excellence Scholarships

Students must demonstrate a high level of achievement and participation in two or more of our four identified areas: academic, leadership, sport, cultural. These scholarships are offered for up to four years. If an applicant has a special strength in music as part of the Cultural component, please note this on the application form and be prepared to attend an audition if required.

### Costs

A **\$100 registration fee** is required for girls to sit scholarship. Those who have already submitted a General Application for enrolment, **do not** have to pay an additional fee. Girls whose mother is an Old Girl of Rangi Ruru Girls' School are exempt from this fee. For those students who are successful in gaining a scholarship to Rangi Ruru, this will be credited to their account when they commence with us.

### Our Fees

- Current tuition fees for 2020 are (inclusive of GST) – Day Student - \$23,600 per annum (for New Zealand students)
- Boarding fees 2020 (where applicable) - \$14,560 per annum
- Incidentals including uniform, stationery, outdoor education camp etc approximately \$2,500 per annum

## Scholarship Offers and Results

The school reserves the right to seek further information from an applicant's present school before a final decision is made.

Once those Scholarships recipients have confirmed their acceptance, all Scholarship entrants will be contacted by email to advise the outcome of their application. **This process can take two to three weeks.**

Tenure of the Scholarship will be reviewed annually and is subject to good conduct, adherence to the Rangī values and academic progress in keeping with the status of the award.
